


Is it necessary to identify the reporter?


The primary purpose of the application is to not identify the reporter. If the reporter wishes to contact the police and the police, they can enter their basic information (name, phone number, email).



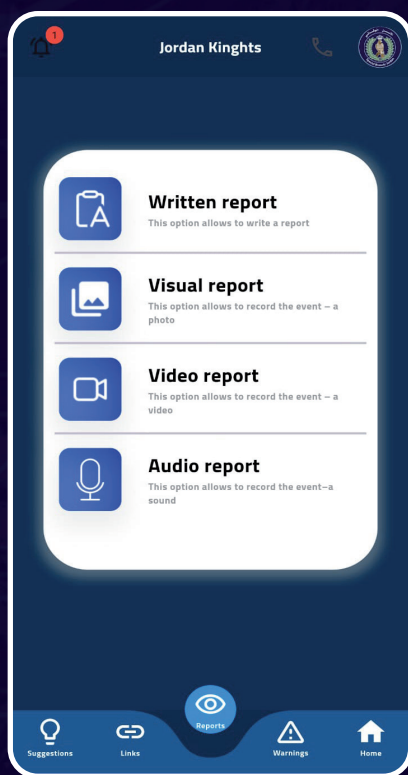

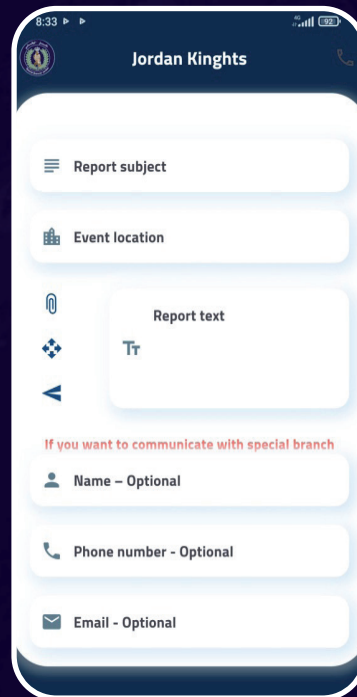
Public Security Directorate
